## By train and cab from Copenhagen Airport to Lund

The trains leave from the Arrival area of Terminal 3. Some trains go all the way through to Lund, but for some connections you will have to change train in Malmö. Buy a ticket to Malmö from the vending machine or at the counter prior to taking the train to Malmö at Track 1. The train leaves every 20 minutes, and it will take you 21 minutes to reach Malmö Central Station (second stop). Stay on the train if it is a direct train for Lund; otherwise change train for Lund. Tak a cab from Lund Station to Epigress.

## By train and cab from Copenhagen Airport to Malmö

The trains leave from the Arrival area of Terminal 3. Buy a ticket to Malmö from the vending machine or at the counter prior to taking the train to Malmö at Track 1. The train leaves every 20 minutes, and it will take you 21 minutes to reach Malmö Central Station (second stop). Many downtown hotels (Mäster Johan, Kramer, Savoy etc.) are within walking distance, otherwise take a cab.

## By cab from Copenhagen Airport to Lund

Take a cab at the exit or ask Epigress to pre-book a cab for Lund at SEK 750. The ride will take 35-45 minutes.

## By cab from Copenhagen Airport to Malmö

Take a cab at the exit or ask Epigress to pre-book a cab for Lund at SEK 565. The ride will take 25-35 minutes.

## **By rental car from Copenhagen Airport to Lund**

Pick up your rental car. Drive from Malmö (Sweden) over the bridge. The toll is SEK 275, one way. Take highway E22 north, direction Kalmar. It will take you 40-45 minutes to get to Lund. Take the third Lund exit (Lund N) and turn left. Continue about 400 m on Norra Ringen. Take left in the first rotary circle, and then immediately left in the next, smaller rotary circle. Turn right after about 150 m. You can now see the Epigress plant with its sign to your right. The building is in the shape of a "U", and the entrance is from the inside of the "U".

## **Money**

The currency in Sweden is Krona (SEK). Credit cards are normally accepted at all places, including by taxi drivers. Exchange rates, as of April 4, 2003, are:

1 SEK  $\approx$  0,12 USD

1 SEK  $\approx$  0,11 EUR

Tips are not expected, even in cabs.
